On 11 November 2014, I submitted a manuscript **MENTAL HEALTH: UNDERVALUED, UNDERFUNDED AND FAILED PRIORITIES** Number: **aaa3815** for consideration of publication in *Science* with a follow up letter of 19 December 2014 requesting whether you plan to publish this essay in *Science*, attached.

Tragically, *the National Institute of Child Health and Human Development* abandoned its Research *obligations* mandated by the Congress under **PL 87-838** that established the mission of NICHD to study the **special health problems and requirements of mothers and children...**(**PL 87-838** Sec 441).

The betrayal and abandonment of the the abused and neglected children and their Mothers by the NICHD/NIH continues to this day in the continuing violation of **PL 87-838** Sec 441.
